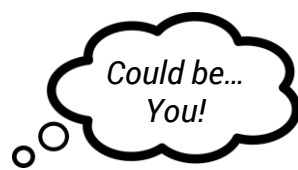

- Partners internally to scope, contract, evaluate and select suppliers for work-for-hire elements such as translations, voice-overs, etc.;
- Actively collaborates with suppliers, clients and colleagues to ensure learning is accessible in multiple languages without learning being lost in translation;
- Builds end-to-end E-Learning modules including teaching and thinking elements, and scoring and feedback; using Articulate 360 or Rise 360;
- Guides internal and external stakeholders to upload, test, release and troubleshoot E-Learning modules based on an in-depth understanding of different types of LMS platforms and their related APIs.
